What is DiscipleNow?

Disciple Now weekend is a weekend retreat that stays within the area First Baptist Church of Plano. The weekend allows students to stay at "Host Homes," which are members of FBC Plano who have graciously offered their homes, while they participate throughout the weekend in worship, Bible study, fellowship, games, and concerts. Our goal is to present each student with an opportunity to experience God in a fresh and new way, while also building community with our Student Ministry.

How can I register?

How much is DiscipleNow weekend and what does it include?

Disciple Now weekend is \$65 dollars for FBC Plano members and \$35 for visitors. That price includes a t-shirt, worship, concerts, and all meals for the weekend. There is financial aid available if you are in need of assistance. The money is due no later than January 9, 2011.

When do I find out what Host Home I will be staying at for the weekend?

On Wednesday, January 12, 2011, we will have a Kick-Off Rally for DiscipleNow. It will take place from 7:00 PM to 8:00 PM in The Refuge. At that time you will find out who is in your group and what home you will be staying at for the weekend, along with receiving your t-shirt, which we ask you to wear on Friday to school.
